- gefnogi gwell cynhwysiant i blant anabl drwy gynyddu'r cyllid ar gyfer Partneriaethau Blynyddoedd Cynnar yng Nghymru a chynyddu'r nifer o leoedd meithrin cynhwysol.
- gwneud Hyfforddiant Cydraddoldeb Anabledd yn rhan hollol glir o'r cwricwlwm Addysg Bersonol a Chymdeithasol a sicrhau bod pob plentyn yn derbyn o leiaf ddwy sesiwn Hyfforddiant Cydraddoldeb Anabledd, wedi eu darparu gan bobl anabl, yn ystod eu gyrfa ysgol
- sicrhau bod gan bob ysgol uwchradd yng Nghymru gynllun wedi'i gostio, wedi ei gyhoeddi yn eu Cynlluniau Datblygu Ysgol ac wedi'i ariannu gan y Cynulliad, i'w wireddu fel darpariaeth cwbl hygyrch o fewn tair blynedd
- sefydlu gweithgor i ymchwilio cyfleoedd Addysg Bellach ac Addysg Uwch ar gyfer gadawyr ysgol sydd ag amhariadau cymhleth ac anghenion cefnogaeth ychwanegol yng Nghymru gyda bwriad o sefydlu coleg arbenigol wedi'i lleoli ar y cyd

- bod, mewn cysylltiad â phobl anabl a'u sefydliadau yng Nghymru, ar flaen y gad o ran datblygu gwasanaethau arloesol a hyblyg i wneud byw annibynnol yn realiti

## Democratiaeth

Mae Scope Cymru yn galw ar y Llywodraeth Cynulliad Cymru newydd i:

- sicrhau bod awdurdodau lleol yn gwneud pob gorsaf bleidleisio yng Nghymru yn hygyrch i bleidleiswyr anabl
- annog awdurdodau lleol i dreialu dulliau pleidleisio newydd, yn cynnwys drwy'r rhynggrwyd a thros y ffôn, er mwyn gwneud y system ddemocrataidd yn gwbl gynhwysol

## Cyfathrebu

Mae Scope Cymru yn galw ar y Llywodraeth Cynulliad Cymru newydd i:

- fod y cyntaf i ymrwymo i hawl dynol sylfaenol pobl anabl sydd ag amhariadau cyfathrebu i siarad drostynt eu hunain, drwy ddarparu £10 miliwn y flwyddyn i ariannu model o wasanaeth cymorth cyfathrebu cydgysylltiedig

## Trafnidiaeth

Mae Scope yn galw ar y Llywodraeth Cynulliad Cymru newydd i:

- wneud defnydd llawn o Ddeddf Trafnidiaeth (Cymru) 2006 i sicrhau bod Cymru yn arwain y byd mewn trafndiaeth gyhoeddus hygyrch
- mynnu safonau enghreifftiol o hygyrchedd ar gyfer pobl anabl fel amod buddsoddi cyhoeddus ym mhob gwasanaeth trafndiaeth gyhoeddus newydd
- neilltuo lleoedd ar gyfer pobl anabl ar y Pwyllgor Defnyddwyr Trafnidiaeth Gyhoeddus neu sefydlu Pwyllgor Trafnidiaeth Pobl Anabl

## Manifesto for Wales – Scope Cymru

### Our Mission

Scope Cymru's aim is that disabled people achieve equality. To achieve this, we need to ensure that children and adults with cerebral palsy and additional support needs are at the heart of our quest for equality in Wales.

### Our Manifesto

Scope Cymru wants to work with political parties in the National Assembly for Wales to banish disablism and help make equality for disabled people a reality.

### Education and Early Years

Scope Cymru calls on the new Welsh Assembly Government to:

- support greater inclusion of disabled children by increasing funding for Early Years Partnerships in Wales and the number of inclusive nursery places
- make Disability Equality Training a clearly identified part of the Personal and Social Education curriculum and ensure all children receive a minimum of two Disability Equality Training sessions, delivered by disabled people, during their school careers
- ensure all secondary schools in Wales have a costed plan, published in their School Development Plans and funded by the Assembly, to be verified as fully accessible within three years
- establish a working group to investigate Further Education and Higher Education opportunities for school leavers with complex impairments and additional support needs in Wales with a view to establishing a co-located specialist college

## Independent Living

Scope Cymru calls on the new Welsh Assembly Government to:

- abandon the unfair and inconsistent charging system and re-commit to its long-standing pledge of introducing free homecare for disabled people in Wales
- be, in conjunction with disabled people and their organisations in Wales, at the forefront of developing innovative, flexible services to make independent living a reality

## Democracy

Scope Cymru calls on the new Welsh Assembly Government to:

- ensure that local authorities make every polling station in Wales accessible to disabled voters
- encourage local authorities to trial new methods of voting, including via the internet and telephone, to make the democratic system fully inclusive

## Communication

Scope Cymru calls on the new Welsh Assembly Government to:

- be the first to commit to the basic human right of disabled people with communication impairments to speak for themselves, by providing £10 million per year to fund a model joined-up communication aids service

## Transport

Scope Cymru calls on the new Welsh Assembly Government to:

- make full use of the Transport (Wales) Act 2006 to ensure that Wales becomes the world leader in accessible public transport
- insist upon exemplar standards of accessibility for disabled people as a condition of public investment in all new public transport services
- reserve places for disabled people on the Public Transport Users' Committee or establish a Disabled Persons' Transport Committee
